# Letters of Recommendation

- You should request 2 teacher letters of recommendation from Hicksville High School teachers.
- You may want to consider additional letters of recommendation from coaches, employers, and/or community leaders. However, these do not replace teacher letters and need to be sent separately.
- Counselors will write letters of recommendation for students upon request.



# The College Essay

- The College Essay is your chance to show what sets you apart from other applicants.
- Students in regents level English classes will work on the college essay in class.
- Keep in mind, some colleges have additional supplemental essays that must be completed as well.



# SAT/ACT

- Fee Waivers
- Superscoring
- ACT vs SAT
- Many schools may be *test optional* or *test blind*. Check the school's admission website to understand their requirements.
- It is your responsibility to send your scores to your colleges directly from your test provider. Your counselor **will not** send your scores

# Student Athletes/Art Programs

- If you are an athlete seeking Division I or Division II scholarships, you must register with register with the NCAA at [www.eligibilitycenter.org](http://www.eligibilitycenter.org). You must ensure you have taken eligible courses as per the NCAA
  - Ask for a fee waiver if you qualify for free/reduced lunch
  - **To check your NCAA eligibility:**
    1. Go to [www.CoreCourseGPA.com](http://www.CoreCourseGPA.com).
    2. Navigate to “Free New Member Account” on the upper left hand side and Enter School ID (332365) and School Code (714533380)
  - **Send your SAT or ACT Scores to the NCAA:** Log in to the testing agency website - The code is “9999” to select the NCAA Eligibility Center as a score recipient (either during exam registration or after exam registration).
- If you are pursuing a degree in the Arts, make sure you find out if your program requires a portfolio or audition. The deadlines for these requirements may be different than the application deadline.



# Early Action vs Early Decision

- Applying by a school's early action deadline may qualify you for scholarship opportunities or give you a higher chance at admission
- It is imperative that you meet all of your deadlines





# Transcript Request Forms

- Transcript Request Forms need to be filled out.
- Forms are available in the Guidance Office and should be given to a guidance secretary.
- Include details of college names, deadlines, the type of application, and fee waiver status.



# Deadlines

- The deadline to submit transcript request forms to the guidance department is **two weeks prior to your earliest college deadline**. This is the rule for all applications except for colleges with a January 1st deadline. **All transcript request forms for colleges with a January 1st deadline are due November 1st, 2023.**
- You should submit transcript request forms as soon as you add colleges to your Common Application and then Naviance.



# Naviance

- When you add a college to your Common Application, you must also add it to “Colleges I’m Applying To” on Naviance in order for your transcripts and letters of recommendation to be sent successfully.
- Schools in Naviance must match the schools in your Common App. If you decide not to apply to a school, delete from both Naviance & Common App.



# On-Site Admissions and College Visits

- Local Colleges will meet with and interview eligible Seniors, waive the application fee, and render a decision on the spot.
- Listen for the announcements on when to sign up in the Guidance Office.
- You must meet the individual school's onsite criteria and complete their application.
- If FAFSA application is complete, some schools may be able to offer financial aid packages on the spot.

# Financial Aid

- You and your family must complete the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) to be considered for any financial aid.
- The application opens on December 1st, 2023, [www.fafsa.gov](http://www.fafsa.gov).

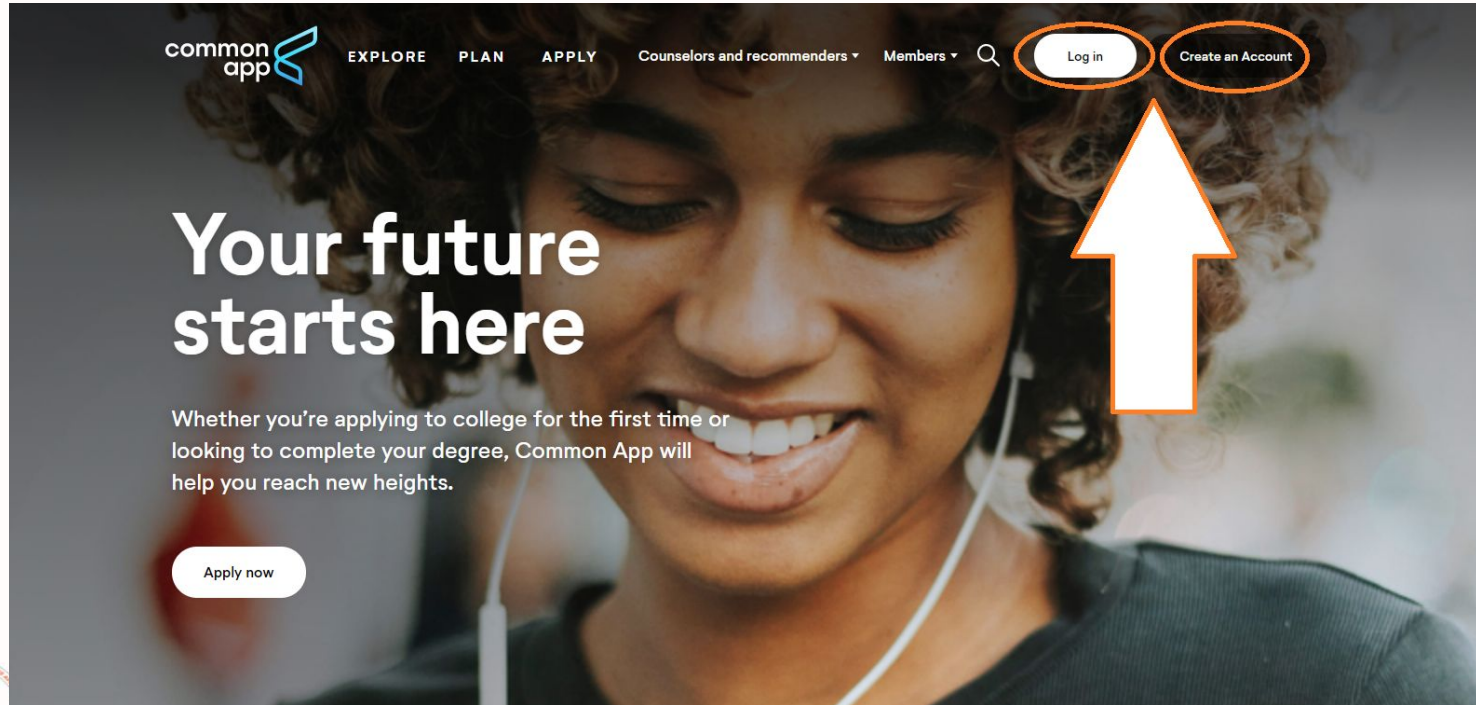


# Naviance-Common App Connect

Before you can invite your counselor, teachers, recommendors, parents, or advisors, you must complete the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) release authorization process.

## ✕ Release Authorization

- FERPA regulates the privacy of student education records, which could include your application to the college where you enroll. FERPA also gives you the right to review confidential letters of recommendation provided as part of that application after you enroll.

### 2. In a moment, you'll be asked if you want to waive the right to review confidential letters of recommendation. What should you know about this waiver?

- Waiving your right lets colleges know that you do not intend to read your recommendations, which helps reassure colleges that the letters are candid and truthful.
- Some recommenders may decline to write a letter for you if you do not waive your rights. Check with your counselor or teachers to see if any of them follow such a policy.

### 3. Still unsure how to respond?

- That's OK. Many students are. Before you move on, take a moment to discuss your decision with your counselor, another school official, or your parent/legal guardian. For more information about FERPA, visit the [Help Center](#).
