Update: June 8, 2021

Dear Parents/Guardians and Students of the Class of 2021,

With recent changes in Department of Health Guidelines, we are happy to announce that Hicksville High School will be offering **two graduation sessions**! Details are outlined below.

Each graduate will be provided with <u>2 tickets</u> for guests. NO ADDITIONAL TICKETS WILL BE AVAILABLE DUE TO CAPACITY LIMITATIONS. These tickets will be distributed along with the graduate's cap and gown.

Each attendee must complete a Daily COVID Health Screening Form (attached) prior to entering the event location. The <u>attached survey</u> must be completed on Saturday, June 26th prior to the event. Any guest that does not complete this requirement <u>will not be permitted to attend the event</u>. There will be no proof of testing or vaccination required to attend graduation. While it is still considered prudent to be tested before attending large-scale events, this documentation will not be required for entry.

Parking will be limited, but available in the lot accessible from Newbridge Road (northbound) as well as the main lot accessible from Division Avenue. The lot will be available on a first-come-first-serve basis. When the ceremony is over, please vacate the property safely and quickly to allow for the second ceremony to begin on time. For guests who park on the street, please observe local parking regulations and walk to the bleachers on the west side (closest to the parking lot). No guest will be permitted access without their ticket for the appropriate ceremony.

Guests will be asked to sit in the bleachers, appropriately distanced at all times. Guests will only be permitted to attend the session that is reflected on their ticket. Tickets will be distributed with caps and gowns on June 21st. Details are outlined below.

On June 21st, all grade 12 students should bring any items that need to be returned. Such items include textbooks, Chromebooks, calculators, etc. After students return their materials, they will pick up their cap and gown and their yearbooks.
